

On July 1, 2025, we will be completing the final phase of our operational merger. This will streamline operations between all U.P. State Credit Union offices. Members will now be able to conduct transactions at any UPSCU branch without using Shared Branching.

Closing Early

We will be closing at **Noon** on Monday, June 30, 2025. We will reopen for business on Tuesday, July 1, 2025, normal business hours.

New Account Number

Member's account numbers will now be an 8-digit account number. **If you are a former Federal Employees of Chippewa County Credit Union member, your account number will remain the same**. All other account numbers will be changing by adding a prefix to your current account number. Your account number will start with a 7 followed by zeros to make 8 digits. For example, if your account is 123456, the new account number would be 70123456.

Account Number Change

Remember this is your new 8-digit account number. Your account number will start with a 7 followed by zeros to make 8 digits.

New Routing Number

You WILL NOT have to change your current direct deposits, automatic payments, checks, and bill payments. We will link your current account structure to your new account for seamless transaction posting. As of July 1, 2025, we ask that you begin using the new 8-digit account number with the new routing number **291172569** when setting up new direct deposits and automatic payments.

Shared Branching

UP State CU-Sault will not be able to be accessed from Friday, June 27 at **3pm** through Monday, June 30. Shared Branching will be available sometime on July 1. You will use the shared branch identifier of **U.P. State Credit Union** for shared branch transactions. You will also need to use your new 8-digit account number. You will no longer be required to use Shared Branching when using other UPSCU branches.

Website

As of July 1, 2025, you will continue to use upscu.com. However, you **will not** need to click UPSCU-Sault to access home banking login.

Electronic Services Enrollment

Online Services CHANGES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2025 Online Banking will not be available after **Noon** on Monday, June 30, 2025 until 8am on Tuesday, July 1, 2025. Please follow the instructions below to re-enroll in Online Banking:

Online Banking: You will need to visit our website at upscu.com and click on Online Banking login to access your online banking. Click "It'sMe247 Online Banking". You will get a notice you are leaving UPSCU.com. Continue. You will need to click "First Time User" and set up the online account with your 8-digit account number.

Mobile Banking: You will need to download the Mobile Banking App. If you have not re-enrolled in Online Banking, you will need to click "First Time User" and follow the prompts. Reminder: You will need to use your new 8-digit account number. If you have already followed the Online Banking steps above and you have created a new username and password, using your 8-digit account number, you will use those credentials for the Mobile App.
